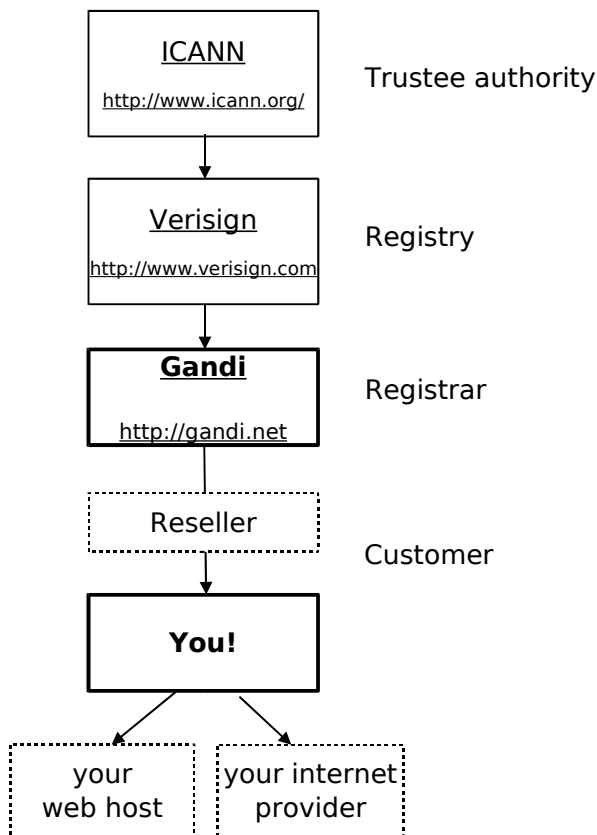

In addition to Gandi's general terms and conditions of domain name registration, the registration and use of a .CC domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions.

Section .CC.2- Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .CC domain name, You acknowledge to have fully understood, and You agree to fully abide by all the rules and specific conditions pertaining to the registration of .CC domain names, as defined by Verisign, and which

These contracts bind You to the Verisign Registry. The present special conditions are not substitutes to these Rules, but are a part of it. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Section .CC.3- Storage and transmission of personal information

In application of ICANN contracts, all personal and technical information associated with the registration of Your domain name is recorded and made available to ICANN, in addition to messages pertaining to each registration or modification, during the entire duration of the registration of the domain name, and beyond during the entire duration that We remain accredited by ICANN, plus the three following years.
