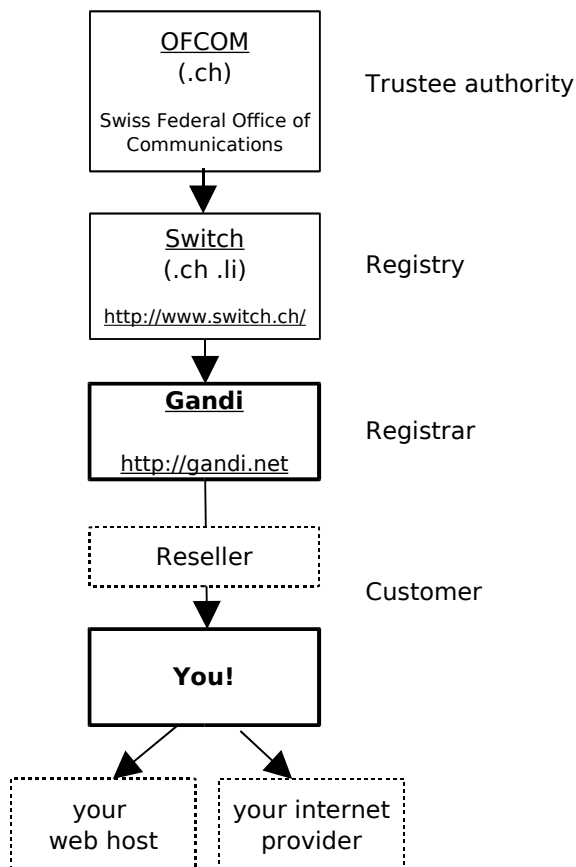
In addition to Gandi's general terms and conditions of domain name registration, the registration and use of a .CH domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions.

When You apply to register a .CH domain name, You acknowledge to have fully understood, and You agree to fully abide by all the rules and specific conditions pertaining to the registration of .CH domain names, as defined by Switch, and which may be viewed at the following address : <https://nic.switch.ch/reg/>

These contracts bind You to the .CH Registry. The present special conditions are not substitutes to these Rules, but are a part of it. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Please note that:

- some requests to modify the domain name must be validated by the owner of the domain name within 10 days following the request, otherwise the modifications can be refused and/or canceled by the Registry;
- some words are forbidden for registration, or reserved, particularly the names of municipalities in Switzerland (see the SWITCH document « List of directories »);
- the nameservers (DNS) associated to the domain name must be functional, correctly specified and configured;
- after the deletion of a domain name, the name is subject by the Registry to a transition period of 14 days.

The transfer to Gandi does not include any renewal for a .ch domain name.

For any transfer request involving an ownership change for a .CH domain name, the owner of the domain name (registrant) must sign and return a paper document to the Registry Switch, by fax or mail, within 10 days.
