

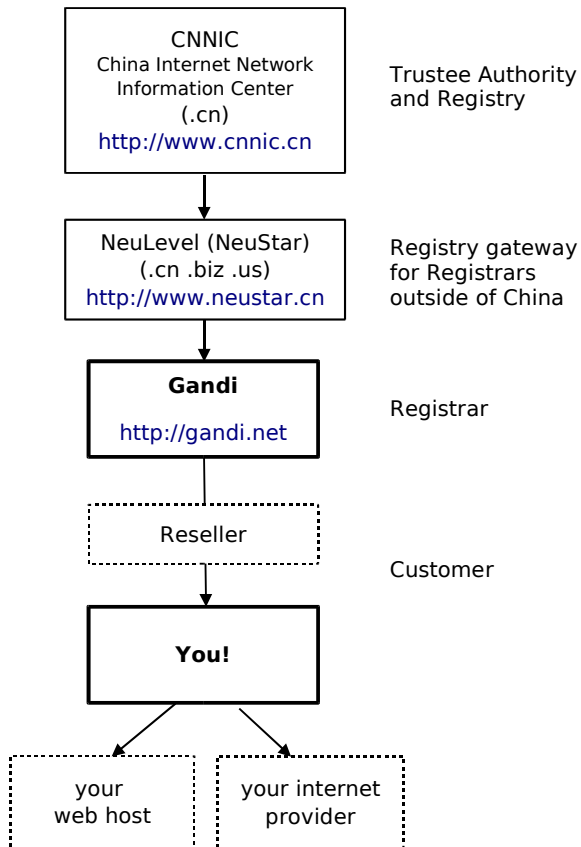
## ANNEX .CN – SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .CN ccTLD

version n°1.0 – May the 14th, 2008

In addition to Gandi's General Terms and Conditions of Domain Name Registration, the registration and use of a .CN domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions. Your contracts are also accessible at the address: <http://www.gandi.net/contracts/>

### Section .CN.1- Trustee Authority and Registry

The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .CN ccTLD:

### Section .CN.2- Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .CN domain name, You acknowledge to have fully understood, and You agree to have full knowledge of and to abide by all the rules and specific conditions pertaining to the registration of .CN domain names, as defined by the Registry CNNIC, and which may be viewed at the following addresses:

Particularly, You shall:

- abide by the laws and the Regulations in relation to the Internet;

- abide by China Internet Domain Name Regulations <http://www.cnnic.cn/html/Dir/2005/03/24/2861.htm> and other relevant rules of governmental authorities (MII Ministry of Information Industry), particularly article Article 27: "Any of the following contents shall not be included in any domain name registered and used by any organization or individual:

- 1) Those that are against the basic principles prescribed in the Constitution [of the Peoples Republic of China "PRC"];
- 2) Those jeopardize national security, leak state secrets, intend to overturn the government, or disrupt of state integrity [of the PRC];
- 3) Those harm national honor and national interests [of the PRC];
- 4) Those instigate hostility or discrimination between different nationalities, or disrupt the national solidarity [of the PRC];
- 5) Those violate the [PRC'S] state religion policies or propagate cult and feudal superstition;
- 6) Those spread rumors, disturb public order or disrupt social stability [of the PRC];
- 7) Those spread pornography, obscenity, gambling, violence, homicide, terror or instigate crimes [in the PRC];
- 8) Those insult, libel against others and infringe other people's legal rights and interests [in the PRC]; or
- 9) Other contents prohibited in laws, rules and administrative regulations [of the PRC]. "

- abide by the Implementation Rules and CNNIC Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy [see below Section .CN.5];

- guarantee the truthfulness, accuracy and integrity of the submitted information, and keep Your information up to date;

- send Us the codes and/or documents that are required for some operations on Your domain name, especially for an ownership change, a domain name deletion, or a domain name transfer request.

Please note that, according to Neulevel's FAQ <http://www.neulevel.cn/faqs/index.html>, the CNNIC Registry has reserved certain names. These include:

- Country names, three-letter and ISO3166
- Chinese government organizations and leaders' names
- Names that are for national security
- Province and city names
- Special telephone numbers. (001), etc.
- All gTLD's and some second-level zones (biz.cn, kids.cn)
- Certain well-known trademarks (about 350)
- Names labeled by the UN to promote world culture,

heritage.

- Chinese universities and colleges
- News Media as approved by the National News Office.

These contracts bind You to the .CN Registry. The present special conditions are not substitutes to these Rules, but are a part of it. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Please also note that Gandi does **not** provide:

- 2-character .CN domain names
- internationalized domain names (IDN)
- third-level domains, such as .com.cn, .org.cn, .gov.cn, ...

### **Section .CN.6- Transfer**

The CNNIC Domain Name Transfer Registrars Rule is available at this address:

At this time, it is only possible to transfer a .CN domain name from or to a Neulevel-accredited Registrar.

Before initiating a transfer request, please ensure that:

- You can provide the authorization code associated with the domain, otherwise the transfer will fail. You can obtain this code from the current registrar, via the domain's owner or administrative contact;
- Your domain does not have a TransferProhibited status;
- Your domain is not about to expire. Domain names scheduled to expire in fewer than 14 days will not be allowed to transfer. We advise You to start the transfer at least 45 days before the expiration date;
- the domain name is older than 60 days.

Upon successfully transferring a domain, it is automatically renewed for one year (the registration period is extended by one year), provided that total unexpired term of registration does not exceed ten (10) years.

Trade is not available for .CN domain names: it is not possible to change the owner of a domain name during a transfer from one registrar to another.

### **Section .CN.7- Deletion Process**

A .CN domain name must be renewed before or on the Expiration date. If You do not renew on time, We will deactivate the domain name. Following this deactivation, You have a 5-day period in which You may renew the domain name. If the domain is not renewed during this period, We will send a delete command to Neulevel, and the status will change into PendingDelete for a 15-day period.

It is possible to restore a .CN domain name during the PendingDelete period. This operation is not free, and cannot be done online; You must contact Gandi's Customer Care Department to perform a restoration.

However, if You delete Your domain name before the anticipated expiration date using Our "Anticipated deletion of a domain" form, there will not be any PendingDelete period. In this case, the domain name will become available for new registration as soon as the Registry CNNIC has taken into account the deletion command.
