

ANNEX .CZ - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .CZ ccTLD



In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) of domain name registration, the registration and use of a .CZ domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi. Your current contracts are freely available for viewing when You log into Your account at: <http://www.gandi.net/admin/contracts/>.

Section .CZ.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.CZ is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Czech Republic. The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .CZ TLD:

Section .CZ.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .CZ domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .CZ domain names, as defined by CZ.NIC, and which may be viewed at the following pages:

These contracts are binding between You and the .CZ Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these Rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these Rules on Our Website.

Section .CZ.3. Special requirements

.CZ special requirements are available on:

.CZ domain names are open to anyone.

To register a .CZ domain name, You must agree to the following conditions:

- the registration term is from 1 to 10 years,
- to avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **no later than 2 days before the Expiration date**,
- provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this the .CZ Registry can delete Your domain name,
- names containing two characters followed by two hyphens are not allowed.

Futhermore, the holders having an address outside the European Union or the European Economic Area agree to provide, upon request of the Registry, judicial request or request of any competent authority (in particular the resolution authority of disputes specific to .CZ), a mailing address within the European Union or the European Economic Area or designate a representative having a mailing address within the European Union or the European Economic Area at which the holder may receive mail. Failing to provide this address within 15 days, the .CZ Registry will be entitled to delete Your domain name(s).

Section .CZ.5. Storage of contact information

You accept that the .CZ Registry can access Your personal data and display it in the public [Whois](#) database.

According to Our contract with CZ.NIC, We have to archive Your

personal data for at least 5 years from the end of Your contractual relationship with Us. CZ.NIC's intended use of supplied data is specified on:

Section .CZ.7. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before starting a transfer request, please ensure that:

- You can provide the authorization code associated with the

domain. You can obtain this code from the current Registrar via the domain's owner or administrative contact, or if relevant directly at the [Registry's website](#),

- Your domain does not have a TransferProhibited status,
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that You start the transfer request at least one month before the domain's Expiration).

The transfer's completion requires your confirmation (by e-mail).

The transfer of a .CZ domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .CZ.8. Ownership change

The ownership change process is available on Our Interface, it requires the confirmation of the two parties by e-mail.

The owner change of a .CZ domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .CZ.9. Deletion process

1 day before the Expiration date, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. All the associated technical services are deactivated. The domain **can not be renewed or restored**, it will be deleted by the Registry, and will become available for registration under the "first-come first-served" basis.
