

ANNEX .FI - SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THE .FI ccTLD



In addition to Gandi's [General Terms and Conditions](#) for domain name registration, the registration and use of a .FI domain name implies the acceptance of and compliance to the present special conditions contained herein.

All Your legal information and contracts can be viewed at any time via Our [website](#). Capitalized terms have the definition attributed to them in Our [General Terms and Conditions](#) of Domain Name Registration. Specifically, "You" refers to the owner of the domain name, and "We" designates Gandi. Your current contracts are freely available for viewing when You log into Your account at: <http://www.gandi.net/admin/contracts/>.

Section .FI.1. Trustee authority and Registry

.FI is the official country code Top-Level-Domain (ccTLD) of Finland. The following diagram presents the various parties involved and the Trustee Authority for the .FI ccTLD:



You can view the information and special rules of each party involved by clicking on the respective links.

Section .FI.2. Registration terms and conditions

When You apply to register a .FI domain name, You acknowledge that You have fully understood, and that You certify to have full knowledge of and that You agree to abide by all the rules and specific conditions of .FI domain names, as defined by FICORA, and which may be viewed at the following pages:

These contracts are binding between You and the .FI Registry. The special conditions contained herein do not replace these rules, but rather form part of them. You acknowledge to have fully understood and accepted these rules on Our website.

Section .FI.3. Special requirements

Eligibility conditions

In accordance with the Registry rules, .FI domain names are open to (<https://domain.fi/info/en/index/hakeminen/kukavoihakea.html>):

- individuals having a domicile in Finland and a Finnish identity number,
- legal persons or private entrepreneurs registered in Finland (into the trade register or the registers of associations or foundations),
- public persons registered in Finland,
- diplomatic missions of foreign states registered in Finland.

The registration into the trade register or the registers of associations or foundations must be final before Your registration request. The business identification code alone, or the fact that You have been entered into the register of the tax administration, does not give the right to apply for a .FI domain name.

Registration procedure

Before any registration request of a .FI domain name, You agree to ensure that the requested domain name does not infringe the rights of third parties:

During the registration of Your domain name on Our website, You shall have to indicate:

- for individuals: Your Finish identity number,
- for legal person: Your registration number into the Finish trade register or the Finish registers of associations or foundations,
- for public persons without a registration number: please contact Our customer service department.

The domain names based on an individual first and last names can be registered only by an individual with the same first and last names or by a legal person having a right on these first and last names (right registered into the Finnish trade register, the Finnish register of associations or foundations, the Finnish trademark register or the European trademark register):

If the requested domain name is based on an individual first and last names, You shall have to indicate this during Your registration request on Our website. In more if You are a legal person, You shall have to indicate the following information:

- the register into Your right on the name has been registered,
- the registration number of Your right (ie : trademark registration number).

In more the Registry can request at any time the evidence of Your right on the domain name.

In any case You agree to provide and maintain accurate, reliable and up-to-date personal contact information, failing this the .FI Registry can delete Your domain name.

Technical conditions

You shall specify nameservers (DNS) that are correctly configured for the domain name that You intend to register, according to the Registry “zonecheck” standards:

Failing to specify DNS correctly configured and correct this within a deadline of 1 month, Your registration request will be canceled by the Registry without any refund.

Reserved or prohibited terms

Some words are reserved or prohibited to registration, in particular:

- individuals first and last names that can be registered as a .FI domain name only by an individual having the same first and last names or by a legal person whose the legal name or the registered trademark contains the first and last names used in the domain name,
- terms specified at the following address are prohibited to registration :

(Section 4), and names containing two characters followed by two hyphens are not allowed.

Registration term

The registration term is 1 year, to avoid any deletion of the domain name, the renewal must be paid and funds cleared **no later than 2 days before the Expiration date.**

Section .FI.5. Storage of contact information

You accept that the .FI Registry can access Your personal contact information and display it in the public [Whois](#) database.

By default the personal information of individuals (except first and last names) is not disclosed in the Registry [Whois](#) public database.

All personal and technical information associated with the registration of Your domain name is recorded by the Registry during the entire duration of the registration of the domain name, plus the following year.

Section .FI.6. Dispute resolution policy

The .FI Registry has set forth a .FI domain name Alternative Dispute Resolution Policy that You agree fully abide by:

Section .FI.7. Transfer (change of Registrar)

The process is started on Our Interface. Before requesting the transfer of the domain, please be sure that:

- You have the domain's authorization code (supplied by Your current Registrar),
- Your domain name does not expire soon (We recommend that you start the transfer request at least one month prior to its Expiration).

The transfer's completion requires Your confirmation (by e-mail).

The transfer of a .FI domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

In accordance with the .FI Registry technical specifications, it is not possible to set a Transfer Prohibited status on a .FI domain name in order to avoid transfers.

Section .FI.8. Ownership change

Owner changes are not available on Our Website. If You need to change the ownership of a domain name, please contact Our customer service department.

The owner change of a .FI domain name does not change the domain's Expiration date.

Section .FI.9. Deletion process

1 day before the Expiration date, the domain name is released by Gandi to the Registry. All associated technical services are deactivated.

At this time, the domain name is placed in Quarantine status and can be restored, in accordance with the terms and conditions

described on Our website and/or as communicated by Our customer service department. The length of the Quarantine period is 28 calendar days.

If the domain is neither renewed nor restored within these deadlines, the Registry will delete the domain name, which will become available for registration on a “first come first served” basis.
